

'100 Club' Rules

1. For a cost of £5 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prize.
3. The total prize money issued in any year less minimal admin. costs, e.g. postage, etc. will be as near as possible to 50% of the total of '100 Club' subscriptions taken in the same year. Because the numbers of people who belong to the club may vary each month it is only possible to express the prizes in terms of percentages of available prize money.
4. For guidance, approx. 62% of the available prize money will be allocated to each of the eleven months, January - November. Each of these month's available prize money would be further apportioned as: 1st Prize of 59%; 2nd Prize of 29%; 3rd Prize 12%
5. For guidance, approx. 38% of the available prize money will be allocated to the bumper month of December. This month's Prize money would be further apportioned as: 1st Prize of 68%; 2nd Prize of 23%; 3rd Prize of 9%.
6. For guidance, assuming that there were no costs and the '100 Club' was full through a complete year, these percentages would represent approx. monetary prizes of:- January - November 1st Prize £100; 2nd Prize £50; 3rd Prize £20: December 1st Prize £750; 2nd Prize £250; 3rd Prize £100
7. The Friends' '100 Club' lottery is a Small Society Lottery and is open to Members, their families and the public. Anyone age 16 and over can join.
8. The Friends will keep a reserve list of potential members if the '100 Club' is oversubscribed and reserve the right either to run more than one '100 Club' concurrently or convert the '100 Club' into a '200 Club' and so on if there is the demand.
9. Payments must be made by standing order and one month's notice of cancellation is required.
10. Members' numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
11. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
12. The draw will take place once during each calendar month, either on the date of a Friends' public event during that month or, if none, at that month's Executive Committee meeting. If neither of these are scheduled, the Executive will decide an alternative day.
13. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your '100 Club' membership application form within 1 week of the first day of the month following the draw.
14. The names of the winners will be published in the Friends' News Update and on the Friends' website.
15. The Friends' '100 Club' or similar will be run by the Executive Committee of the Friends. In case of any dispute the decision of the Executive is final.
16. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Friends' '100 Club' if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
17. If a winner cannot be contacted within 6 months, the winnings will be assumed to be a donation and placed into the Friends' funds.
18. Remember 50% of the '100 Club' fees will go towards helping this Charity to look after the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park.
